

MVR EVALUATION CRITERIA

Suggested MVR Evaluation Criteria Guidelines:

1. Valid, current drivers' license, with no major convictions within the past 3 years.

Major convictions include DWI, DUI, Hit and Run, Vehicular Homicide or Assault, License Suspension or Revocation, Reckless Driving, Speeding 20 MPH above posted limit.

2. No more than 2 moving violations or at-fault accidents or combinations of violations / accidents within past 3 years.

Moving violations include Speeding 20MPH or less above posted limit; Stop Sign/Traffic Light Violations, etc.

3. Drivers should be licensed for at least 3 years. (If permitted in driver's state)
